

IRON CHROMATE

**Characteristics:**

Iron chromate is used in glazes to produce shades of grey, brown or black. If the glaze base contains zinc, iron chromate will produce a brown color. If tin is present in the glaze, a pink or reddish brown may be expected. Iron chromate reacts much the same way as would additions of iron and chrome, but is capable of producing colors which can't be achieved with any other combination of oxides.
